Proceeding of SAC Meeting 22 May' 2014

Pre Kharif 15th SAC meeting was held at Krishi Vigyan Kendra Dindori on 22 May' 2014, under the chairmanship of Dr. M.K. Hardaha Joint Director Extension , JNKVV Jabalpur , the house was introduced followed by the Technical Session. The meeting started with the registration of the members followed by introduction of members to the house. Programme Coordinator Krishi Vigyan Kendra and the member secretary of the meeting briefed the objectives and mandates of the KVK along with the presentation of Rabi 2013-14 result and Kharif 2014 activities followed by the presentation of Annual Action Plan proposed for Kharif 2014. The house was of the opinion that demonstrations should be continued for successive years, here the concern of ZPD was communicated and it was informed that in future OFT's will be repeated for at least two years and it will have more than one treatments in assessment.

The problem of cuscuta in Niger and effect of inherent Neurotoxin in Kodo (material) was serious concern, approach made by KVK were briefed to the house at the same time the chairman directed that these issues should be sent to the Research wings DWSR and DRS respectively for further research, which has been done with a copy to Zonal Project directorate for necessary support.

Looking to the weather forecast and presumptions the low precipitation is expected. The house was informed about the contingent plan developed by KVK and the contingent plan was discussed on 27.05.2014 with the line department and convergence staff of the district as desired by the DM dindori also.

The house was informed about the common ring programme of SRI with differential spacing (20,25, 30 cm R-R)). Use of modified konoweeder as suggested by Mr. Rajput from ASHA, it was decided that the instrument will be made to Agril Engineer at JNKVV, Jabalpur for product testing. Looking to the climatic resilience it was decided that in case SRI is not possible use of hand operated 12 kg wt light seed drill developed by the Department of Agriculture Engineer should be tried. Input was got from DDA Dindori.

DPM TEJASWANI Project Mr S.K.Tiwari expressed his concern over Millet Kodo/Kutki processing and value addition feedback available with KVK was shared as millet processing plant is function in the centre and is a part of Honorable Chief Minister Khet Teerth Yojana, further possibility of developing ready to serve products as Kodo Idli Mix and Kutki Kheer mix discussed and necessary help assured by Food technologist Dr Harish dixit PC KVK dindori. Further the existing millet mill being Ragi processor, the kodo millet processing is difficult. This machine requires some calibrations the chairman Dr Hardaha assured that some Mtech student will be assigned project for refinement in the existing null.

Honorable Chief Minister directed video conferencing with farmers for direct interaction is still pending request was made for transfer of school bus not in use at works Section Jabalpur to execute the Project E-Mobile Chaupal. ASCO Shri Deharia requested for making available mobile Soil testing Van for the District which was accepted and programme/requirement welcomed. Shri S.K. Tiwari DPM Tejaswani requested for possibilities of Safflower, he was linked with Mr Singh Principal Scientist Safflower AICRP, Indore for technical advice and his curiosities were fulfilled regarding Safflower cultivation, the crop would help to reduce Rabi damages by wild animals due to its spiny nature. KVK was advised to plan OFT and at crop cafeteria during discussion on SMI the DDA was of opinion that this is not feasible at the district however KVK will have the demonstration at KVK Unit.

Assistant Project Director ATMA requested for more technical support KVK concern of least HRD available was brought in to notice and request for additional staff made. The meeting was concluded with the vote of thanks by the Chairman.
